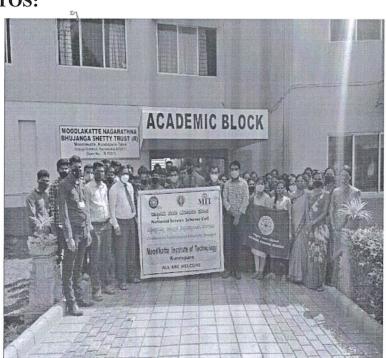

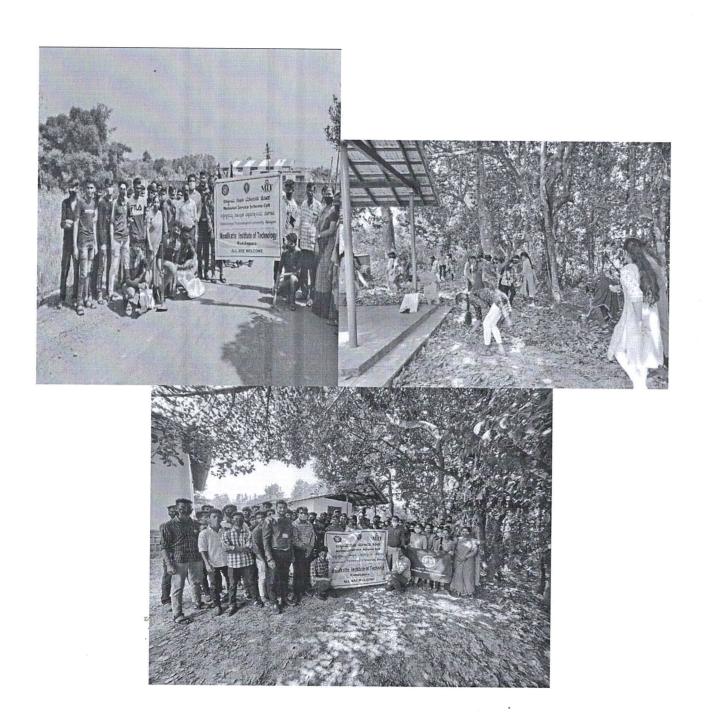
FEEDBACK
