Conclusion:

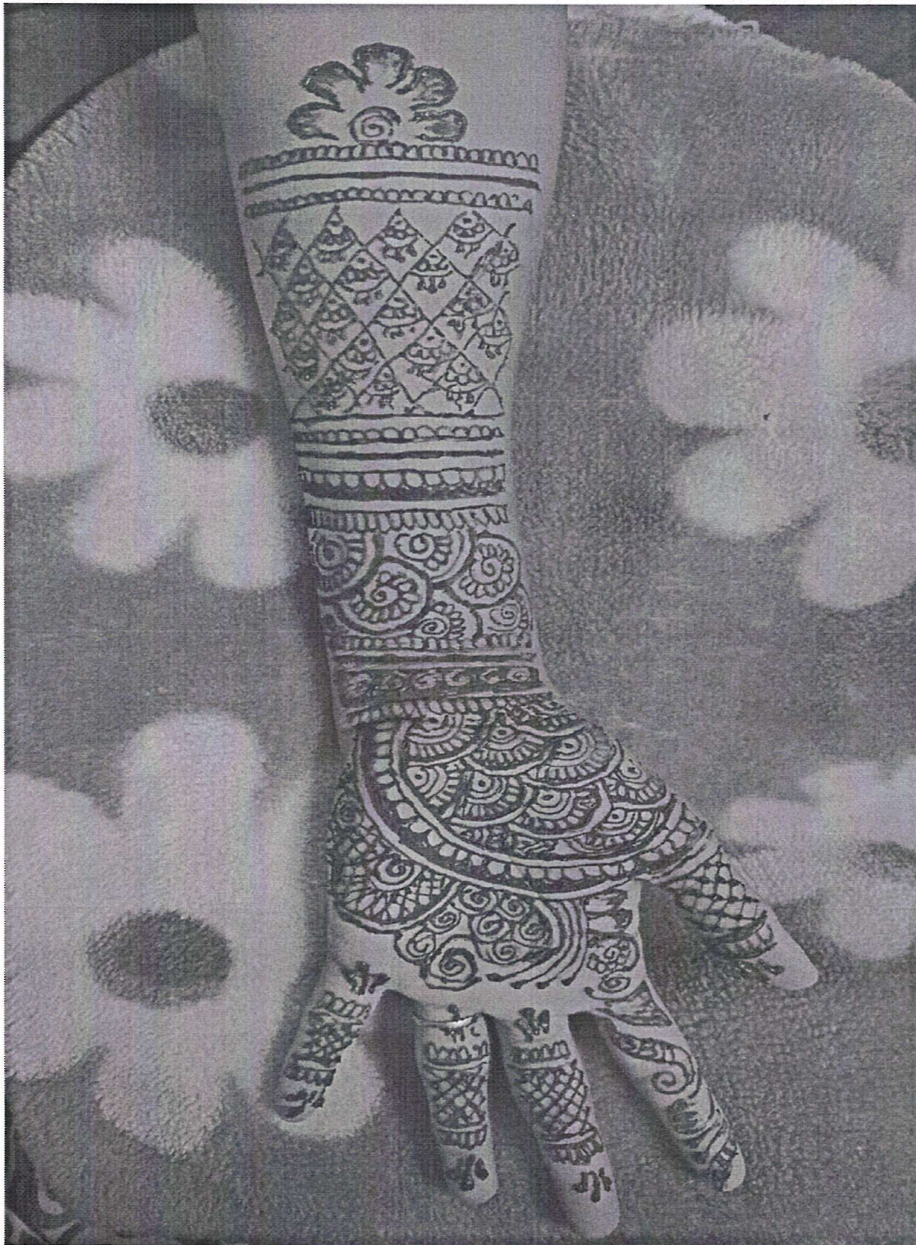

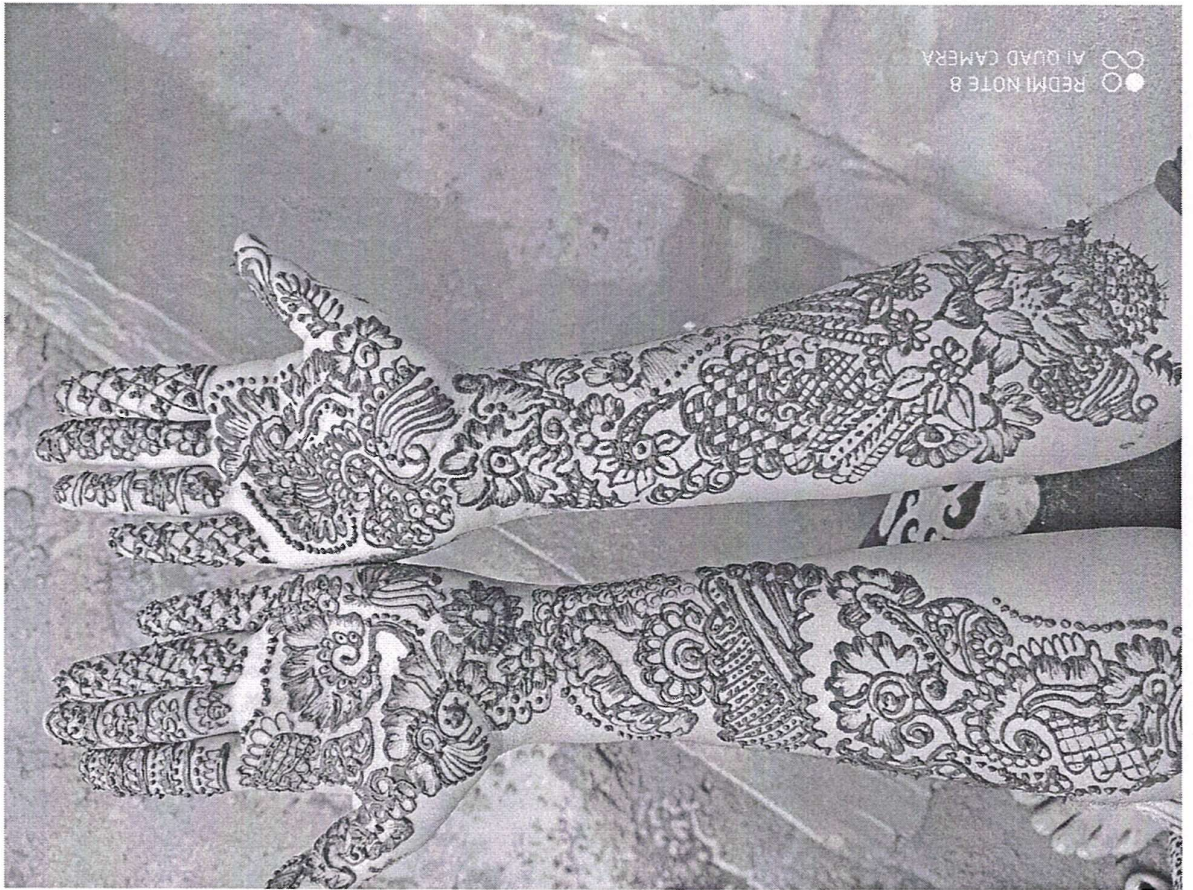
