### 3. Mission

2. To **build collaborations** with industries, universities, and research organizations for innovation and knowledge exchange.
3. To **protect intellectual property rights (IPR)** resulting from institutional research and innovation.

- Review and approve publications, patents, and IPR applications.
- Conduct awareness programs on research ethics and IPR.
- Maintain records of all research activities and outcomes.
- Liaise with external agencies for research collaboration and funding opportunities.
